

The Office of University Writing is seeking nominations for the Sixth Annual Outstanding ePortfolio Award. The purpose of this award is to recognize exceptional ePortfolios created by Auburn University students.

## Eligibility and Nomination

Auburn University faculty/staff members from all departments are invited to nominate up to two students (undergraduate and graduate) who have created distinguished ePortfolios. Students may also nominate themselves.

## Submission Criteria

The following policies apply to nominations:

1. Eligible nominees include Auburn University undergraduate and graduate students enrolled in courses during the 2018 spring semester or during the 2018-2019 academic year.
2. Nomination forms (<https://www.surveymoz.com/s3/4446365/2019-Outstanding-ePortfolio-Award-Nomination>) must include a link to the nominee's ePortfolio.
3. The nominee acknowledges that submitted ePortfolios may be used for future education and training purposes within the Auburn University ePortfolio Project.

## Selection Criteria

Nominations should be professional ePortfolios directed to an external audience. Nominations will be evaluated utilizing the [ePortfolio Project rubric](#) that is based on the four student learning outcomes of the project:

- Effective communication
- Critical thinking through reflection
- Visual literacy
- Technical competency

## Recognition of Award Winners

A luncheon for the finalists, their guests, and their nominator will be hosted by Provost Bill Hardgrave.

## Deadline for Nominations
